NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION ISSUES SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF ABC PERMITS AT GREENSBORO BUSINESS

RALEIGH – The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission suspended the ABC permits for a Greensboro business, Blind Tiger, on August 5, 2022. The suspension came as a result of a review of affidavits submitted by special agents of North Carolina Alcohol Law Enforcement (ALE) and officers of the Greensboro Police Department (GPD).

Blind Tiger, at 1819 Spring Garden Street, Greensboro, has held permanent ABC permits since August 25, 2017.

The summary suspension is immediate and is in effect until the case is heard by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The action is authorized under N.C. General Statute <u>150B-3(c)</u>, which states: "The proceedings shall be promptly commenced and determined."

This is the first summary suspension issued this year by the NC ABC Commission.
