NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION ISSUES SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF ABC PERMITS AT JACKSONVILLE BUSINESS

RALEIGH – The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission has suspended the ABC permits for a Jacksonville business, Champs Lounge. The suspension was served on December 5 and came as a result of a review of sworn statements submitted by Jacksonville Police Department (JPD) officers, a letter from the City of Jacksonville Director of Public Safety, as well as a voluntary statement from a gunshot wound victim.

Champs Lounge, at 93 Western Blvd, Suite E, Jacksonville, has held ABC permits since January 2016.

The summary suspension is immediate and is in effect until the case is heard by the Office of Administrative Hearings. The action is authorized under N.C. General Statute 150B-3(c), which states: "The proceedings shall be promptly commenced and determined."

This is the eighth summary suspension issued this year by the NC ABC Commission and is part of the Commission's ongoing focus on public health and public safety.
