## NORTH CAROLINA ABC COMMISSION HOLDS REGULAR MEETING

RALEIGH – The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and ratified 69 hearing cases that resulted in penalties in excess of \$82,800 and/or imposition of suspensions of permits for three days or more. Fines are due on or before July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025, and suspensions begin July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

The Commission revoked the permits for Reba's Bar & Grill Inc. pursuant to  $\frac{818B-900(a)(3)}{2}$  and  $\frac{818B-104(a)(2)}{2}$ .

The Commission approved an exemption request pursuant to <u>§18B-1116(b)</u> for Neuse River Brewing Company, Blotto LLC, Ryan Kolarov, and Jennifer Kolarov.

The Commission approved an exemption request pursuant to <u>§18B-1116(b)</u> for MOBA Brewing Company LLC; Ibis Coffee and Cocktails LLC T/A Ibis Coffee and Cocktail Bar; Ray McGee Enterprises LLC T/A Starling Whiskey and Wine Bar; Park Vista NC Diner, LLC; Dennison, Cross & Moore Investments, Inc T/A The Half Sandwich and Beverage; Matthew Ray; Benjamin Ray; and Carl Cross.

The Commission approved staff to continue with the proposal of text for sections .0100 through .0300 of 14B NCAC <u>Subchapter 15C</u>. The notice of text will be filed with the Rules Review Commission on June 23<sup>rd</sup> and published on July 15<sup>th</sup>. This is part of the Commission's ongoing mandatory rules review pursuant to <u>§150B-21.3A</u>.

The Commission approved October 8<sup>th</sup>, November 5<sup>th</sup>, and December 10<sup>th</sup> of 2025 as future Commission meetings. The Commission also confirmed the next monthly meeting will be held at the NC ABC Commission (400 E. Tryon Road, Raleigh, NC 27610) on Wednesday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 10:00 am.
